

HENDERSHOT FAILS TO COME

Guggenheim Fund Disclaims Connection With "Fuelless" Motor.

Lester J. Hendershot, inventor of the so-called "fuelless" motor did not appear in New York yesterday, although it had been reported that he was on his way here. At the office of the Guggenheim Foundation it was said that they had not heard from him, and later issued the following statement:

"During the last few days newspaper reports have mistakenly connected the name of the Daniel Guggenheim Fund for the Promotion of Aeronautics with a reported invention of an electromagnetic motor. The fund has no connection whatsoever with this enterprise. Some months ago the reported invention was submitted to certain members of the fund for their consideration, but the fund was unwilling to take any action in regard to it until it had been exhaustively tested."
