

HENDERSHOT STILL ILL

**Inventor In Washington Hospital
Won't Talk to Reporters.**

Washington, March 10.—Lester J. Hendershot, inventor of the "fuel-less motor," was still in a serious condition at Emergency hospital here today from an electric shock he received last Tuesday.
